II Requirement for Admission

Applicants who meet all the following criteria may apply for the course.

- ① Those who have completed high school education or those who have academic ability equal to high - school graduates.
- ② Those who have completed 12 years or more of formal school education or those who have equivalent academic qualifications.
- ③ Those whose Japanese level is equal to or higher than JLPT N5 or those who have been recognized by the school as having equivalent ability or those who have more than 150 hours of learning Japanese.
- ④ Those who are able to pay the tuition and living expensed from admission to graduation.
- ⑤ Those who are honest and sincere, diligent, and have the desire to learn Japanese.
- ⑥ Those who are healthy.
- ⑦ Unmarried and without children to care for.

III Application Documents

◆ Instructions

- ① Application documents must be filled in by the applicant and financial sponsor and there must be no omissions.
- ② Application documents should be submitted according to our instruction if there is a shortage or an error
- ③ If any false entry was found, the application cannot be accepted. And if false entry was found after the acceptance of application, the school might rescind the decision of acceptance.
- ④ All documents written in languages other than Japanese or English must be submitted with Japanese or English translation.
- ⑤ Application documents might differ depending on nationalities.
- ⑥ Additional documents might be required if necessary.
- ⑦ Unmarried and without children to care for.

Note 1	We strongly recommend submitting certificates and score reports of JLPT and NAT-TEST. In principle applicants are requested to submit a copy of certificate of JLPT N5 or NAT-TEST Level 5.	
Note 2	The original shall be returned to the applicant after the examination by Immigration Bureau. If the applicant is still in university or on a temporary leave from university, please submit the registration certificate of university and the diploma of high school.



◆ Flow : From Application to Enrollment

	STEP1 : Send application form for IRIS, pay examination fee, Submit application documents	<p>Please submit the application form and pay the examination fee.</p> <p>Then, please send all necessary documents for the application by the deadline for submitting documents to the Iris Japanese Language School. Also, please transfer the examination fee to the designated account by the deadline.</p>
	STEP2 : Screening Application Documents (by school)	<p>After receiving your documents, we examine them and decide acceptance or rejection. We issue 'Admission Permit' for successful applicants and send forward the documents to the Immigration Bureau.</p>
	STEP3 : Examining Documents (by Immigration Bureau) <u>Issue of 'Certificate of Eligibility'</u>	<p>After examining the documents, the Immigration Bureau issue a 'Certificate of Eligibility.'</p>
	STEP4 : Payment of Tuition Fee <u>Sending Documents to Applicants</u>	<p>We inform the applicants of the results. The successful applicants (or agents) are expected to pay the entrance fees and tuition fees (including other charges) to our bank account. On receipt of payment we send 'Certificate of Eligibility', 'Admission Permit', and a schedule for new students to the successful applicants.'</p>
	STEP5 : Application for VISA <u>Issue of Visa</u> <u>Application for Students Dormitory</u> <u>Arrangement of Air Ticket</u>	<p>If you need to be picked up at the airport, or need school accommodation, please fill in the form and send by fax as soon as possible. When you have acquired a visa from Japanese Embassy in your country and booked a flight to Japan, please inform us of your arrival date in Japan. You are strongly advised to arrive in Japan on our designated day.</p>
	STEP6 : Coming to Japan	<p>A member of our staff meets you at the airport if you wish.</p>
	STEP7 : Enrollment in Iris Japanese Language School	Orientation, Course starts!

- ※ 'Others' includes fees for textbooks, extracurricular activities and insurance.
- ※ The examination fee, ¥20,000 shall be paid at the time of filing application.
- ※ The examination fee shall not be returned for whatever reasons, whether you pass or fail.
- ※ In addition to the fees above, we might charge you for some school events.
- ※ These fees are effective for admissions in April and October 2026. The fees might be changed from April 2026 on.
- ※ You are required to pay for the National Health Insurance (approx. ¥22,000).

VII Refund of tuition and other fees

*The application fee is a screening fee to determine whether or not the school will grant admission. (It is not an immigration application fee.) Therefore, it is non-refundable regardless of the result of acceptance or rejection of the applicant's major at the school.

*The remittance fee is the responsibility of the applicant.

*Once tuition fees have been paid, they are non-refundable except in the following cases.

① Before enrollment

In the event that the applicant does not apply for a visa, the tuition fee except for the enrollment fee will be refunded.

If you fail to obtain a visa after completing the proper procedures, we will refund all fees except for the enrollment fee.

If a student withdraws from the program for personal reasons after obtaining a visa, the full amount of the tuition fee will be refunded except for the entrance fee.

② After enrollment

In the event that a student withdraws from the course without a valid reason, the tuition fee will not be refunded as a general rule.

VIII Dormitory Fee

Those who wish to live in the school dormitory are required to pay the following fees.
